### B) Speaking & Listening => 18 minutes

Speaking = 2 tasks

1. Topic => 4 minutes  
Support: Candidate must use Topic Form with 4 points (see attachment)

Task focus: The candidate is expected in this task and throughout the speaking exam to show their ability to use the language functions of the level. These functions are:

- Giving reasons, opinions and preferences
- Describing the future, informing and expressing intention
- Predicting and expressing certainty and uncertainty
- Describing past actions in the indefinite and recent past
- Expressing obligation
- Asking for information and opinions

2. Conversation => 2 minutes (1 conversation topic from the list of Subject areas)

Subject areas:

- Travel
- Money
- Fashion
- Rules and regulations
- Health and fitness
- Learning a foreign language

Listening = 2 tasks

1. Independent listening => 4 minutes 30 seconds  
(length of recording: 1 minute 15 seconds)
2. Independent listening => 5 minutes 30 seconds  
(length of recording: 1 minute 30 seconds)
